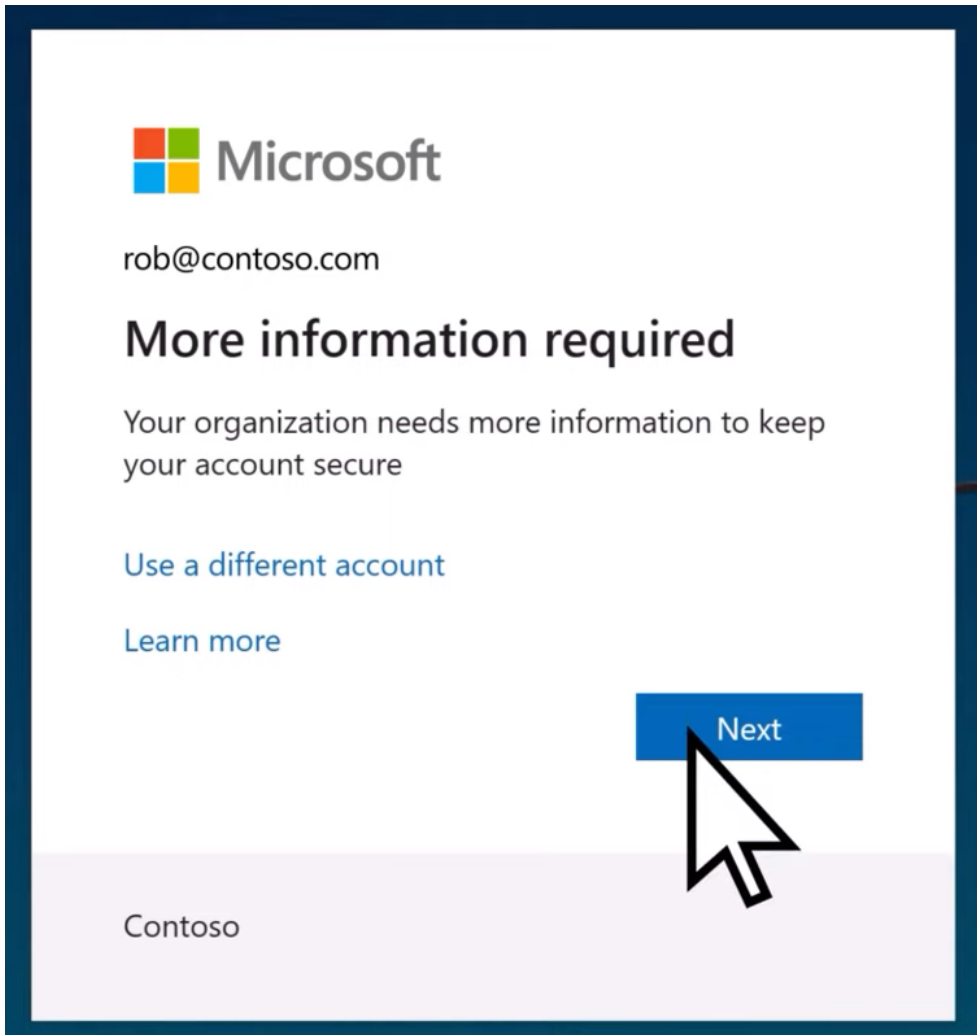




Microsoft Authenticator
