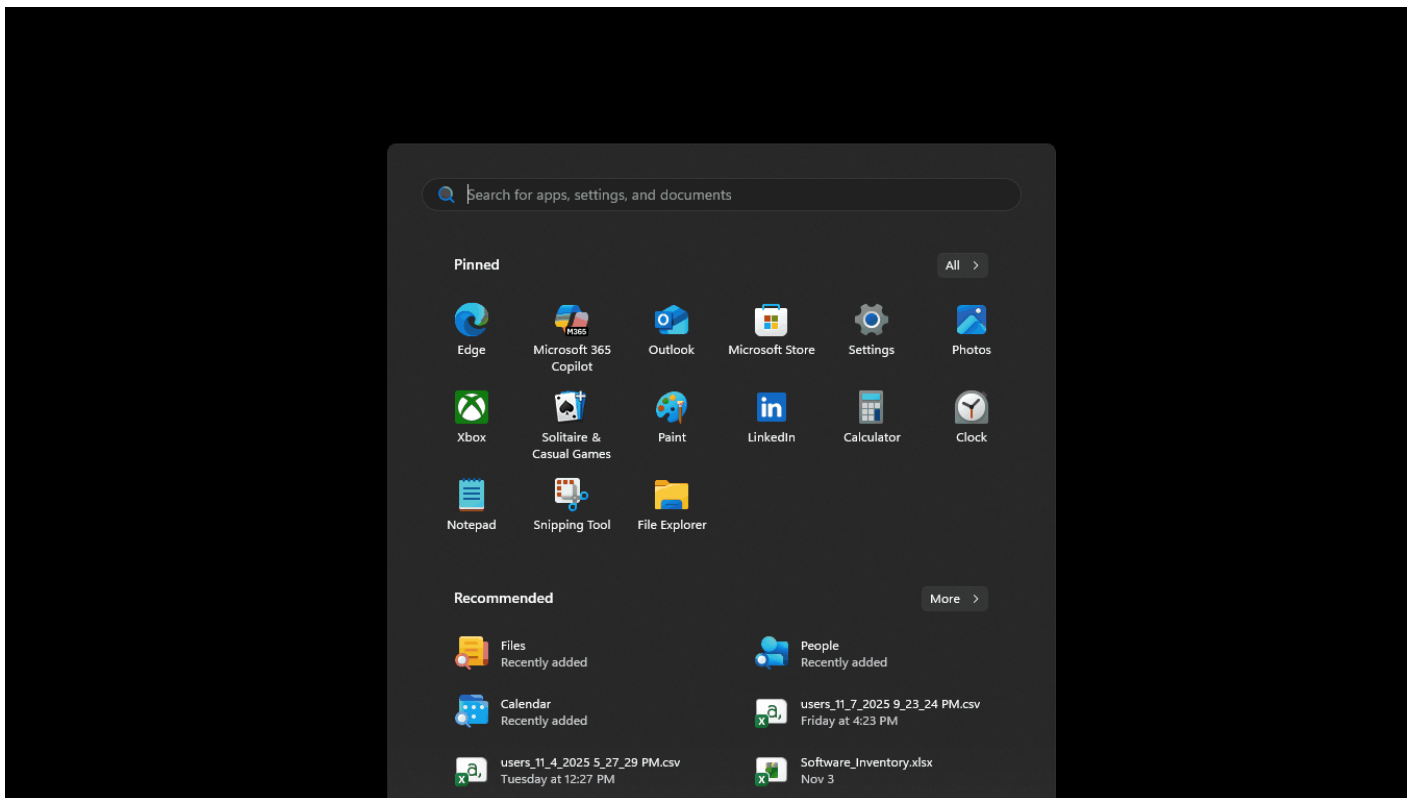

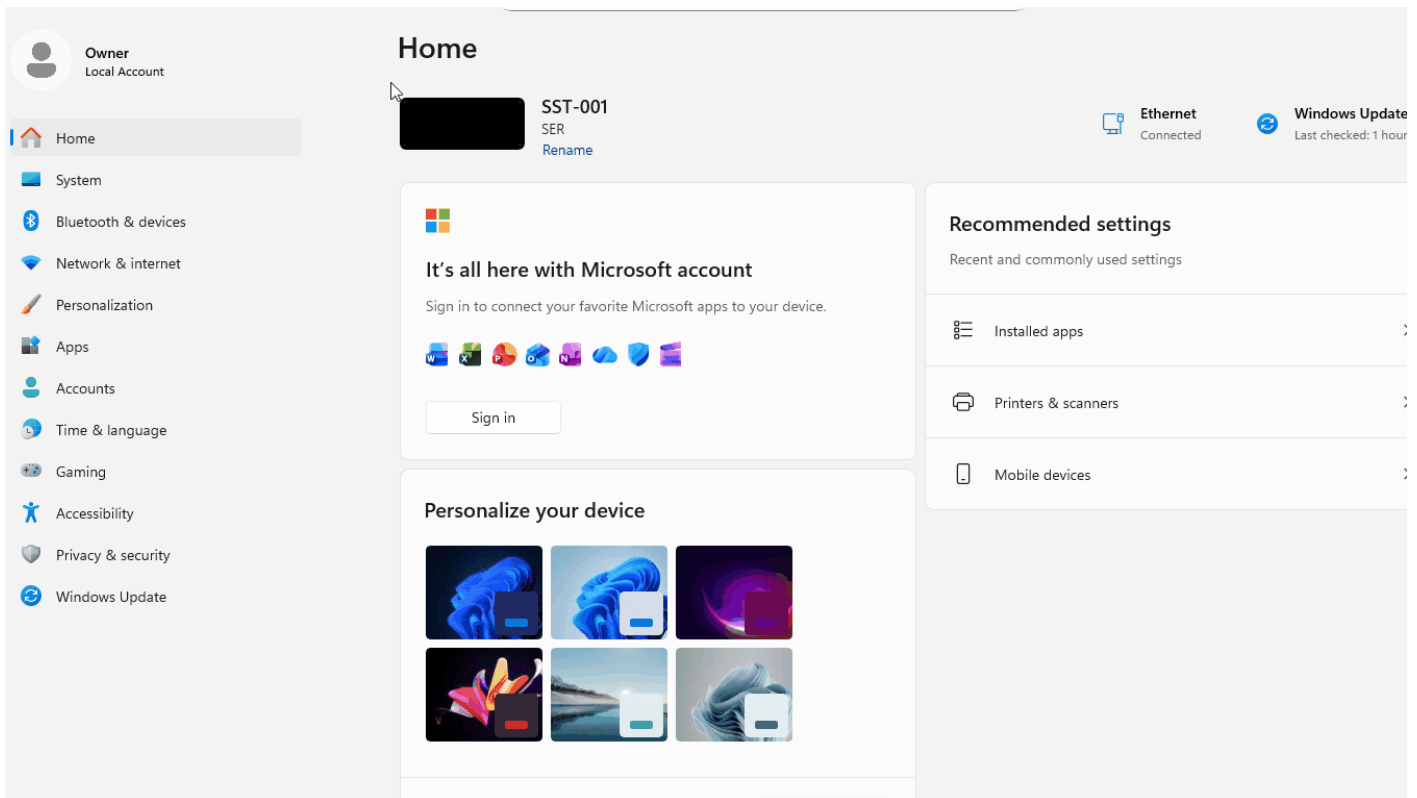
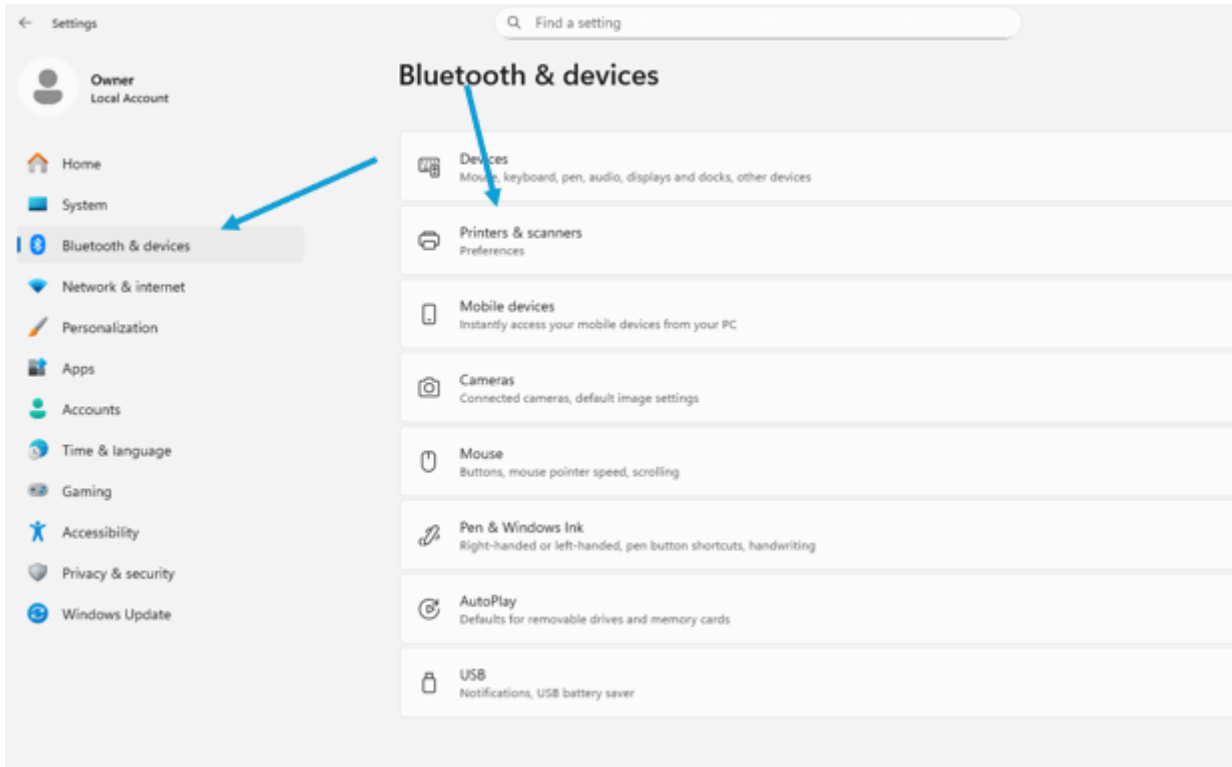

Head to your settings



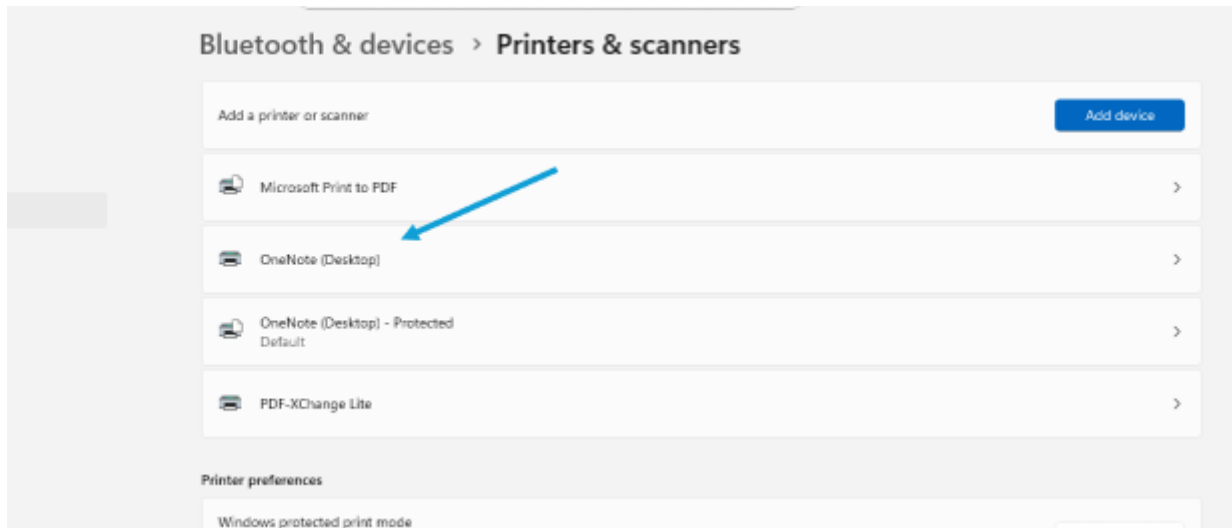
Step 2
